Questions for Reflection and Application

1.) This passage is full of legal terms such as bear witness (1:15), testimony (1:19), confession (1:20), as well as the idea of interrogation. When considering a courtroom, what does it mean to give testimony or bear witness?

2.) If you are a Christian, you have a testimony about Jesus. Often our testimony consists of three parts: 1) who were you? 2) what did Jesus do? 3) who are you? Share with someone in your group a short version of your testimony.

3.) Why do we often fail to share our testimony of Jesus with others?

4.) Does understanding that you have King Jesus' authority to share your testimony of King Jesus embolden you? Why or why not?

5.) Read 1 Corinthians 3:6-8. On Sunday we learned that we do not have to tell everyone the whole gospel message every time we share. Sometimes we only have a brief moment or can only share a little bit. Does this encourage you? Can you think of some opportunities in your life where you could share or have been able to share a little with someone?

6.) Think of someone you can pray for this week that you can share the gospel with. Ask a friend to pray for you and for God to open the door.
