Questions for Reflection and Application

1. When the woman discovered who Jesus was, she left behind her water jar (John 4:26-28). The water jar was a picture of her God replacements (idols). Can we learn something from this in our struggle with sin? Where should we look for the answer?

2. Read John 4:16-18. Jesus was willing to get personal in his conversation with the woman. Does this challenge you? Within the church where do we tend to keep conversations, on the surface or going deeper? How can you challenge the status quo?

3. Jesus highlights the difference between external worship (John 4:19-21) and heart worship (John 4:22-24). Where do you personally struggle with worship remaining external? Where do we as a church struggle with worship remaining external? How can you/we grow in more heart engaging worship in spirit and truth?

4. What stands out to you about the woman's response to Jesus revealing himself? Why does this stand out to you?

5. Spend some time praying for one another about this passage.
