1. We feast on the life of God (6:52-59).

2. God's life is ours by the Spirit (6:60-65).

3. God alone gives life (6:66-71).

Questions for Reflection and Application

1. Read John 6:60-61. What are some sayings of Jesus that are hard for you? What do you struggle with about those statements?

2. We can choose to either accept what Jesus says or reject it. What do many of his followers do, and what do the twelve do? See John 6:66-69.

3. The Gospels are full of accounts of the inability of his twelve to understand a lot of what Jesus was saying. Yet they still remained his followers (except for Judas). John 6:68 tells us something unique about Jesus from everyone else. What is the significance of Jesus' words even if they are hard?

4. Earlier Jesus said that life is given by the Spirit (John 6:63). He says the flesh cannot help us. What are the things the flesh works (Gal 5:16-21)? What are the things that the Spirit produces (Gal 5:22-23)?

5. If the life of God is ours (John 6:57), by the Spirit of God (John 6:63), then what will be the fruit of our lives?

6. Spend some time praying through Psalm 19 together. You can do this by each person taking a verse or two and praying it in their own words, or speaking to God about those verses.
