Questions for Reflection and Application

1. We have been considering the wounds people have received in the church. Have you been wounded by people in the church? Have you wounded people in the church?

2. Read the prophecy about Jesus in Zechariah 13:6. Can you identify with being one of those who wound the Savior? Read Matthew 25:40, 45. What do we see about the way we treat others and how that relates to Jesus?

3. Read Galatians 5:22-23. From these verses, can the fruit that the Spirit grows in us happen in solitude? Why or why not?

4. How do we grow in patience, gentleness, kindness, and love? In solitude or in community?

5. If you have been wounded by the church, you can identify with Jesus in Zechariah 13:6. If you have wounded people, then you have wounded Jesus. The fact of the matter is that we have all done both. Is there someone you have wounded from whom you need to ask forgiveness?

6. Spend some time praying for the health of our local church, that we would be a house of healing for the spiritually wounded.
