**Questions for reflection and application:**

1. On Sunday, we learned that doubt is often the result of disillusionment and unmet expectations. Describe a time in your life that doubt began to move in.

2. The solution to doubt is the Word of God. Read Romans 10:17. If the Word of God is the answer to doubt, why are we so prone to turn to other things? See Romans 7:17, 20, 23.

3. How should we hear the Word of God even in the midst of our afflictions? See 1 Thessalonians 1:6.

4. Read Ephesians 5:18-19 and Colossians 3:6. What relationship does being filled with the Spirit have with being filled with the Word of God? What does this show us about the importance of the Word of God in the life of the believer?

5. If you do not already have a lifestyle of reading the Bible, make a plan by picking a book of the Bible to work through. Maybe do this in connection with another brother or sister so that you can share with one another what you are learning and how your faith in God is growing.
