Discussion and Application Questions

1. Remember Who You Were (2:1-3)

2. Know Who You Are (2:4-7)

3. Walk Accordingly (2:8-10)

1. Reflect on your life before knowing Christ. How can you now see you were spiritually "dead" or separated from God? Why is it important to remember who we were?
2. What does Paul mean by the phrase "dead in trespasses and sins" in verse 1? How does this describe the state of humanity without Christ?
3. How do the actions described in verses 2-3 reflect the spiritual condition of people apart from God?
4. Why is salvation emphasized as a gift of God's grace in verse 8? How does this truth impact the way we view our relationship with God?
5. Why is it important that salvation is not based on our works (verse 9)? How might relying on our own works affect our understanding of God's grace?

6. In what areas of your life do you tend to rely on your own efforts rather than trusting in God's grace? How can you surrender those areas to Him?

7. What does verse 10 teach about what God has purposed for us? How do good works relate to God's grace and salvation?

8. Identify some practical ways in which you can engage in good works in your community, workplace, or family.

9. How can you encourage others in the church to actively participate in good works and serve those in need?
