Questions for Reflection and Application

- 3. To leave the place of comfort (this mountain, Deut 1:6) is to act in faith. What steps of faith do you sense the Spirit leading you into over this next year?
- 4. We can take steps of faith because there are promises of God that we hold onto (See Deut 1:8; 2 Peter 1:3-4). Considering question 3, what are some of the promises of God that you can hold on to as you move forward in 2024?
- 5. Commit to making these things a point of prayer as you seek to grow over the coming year.
