## Questions for application and discussion:

1. What is the significance of Paul's statement, "Flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God" (1 Corinthians 15:50)?
2. How does Paul contrast the perishable with the imperishable in this passage? What does Paul mean when he says, "We will all be changed" (1 Corinthians 15:51)?
3. In what ways does Paul describe victory over death in these verses?
4. How does the victory over death through Christ impact the believer's perspective on life and death?
5. Reflect on your own understanding of the perishable and imperishable aspects of life. How can you focus more on eternal matters rather than temporal ones?
6. Reflect on areas of your life where you might be holding on to the perishable rather than embracing the imperishable. By God's enabling, how can you shift your focus?
7. What is one thing from Sunday's message or the group discussion that you can ask prayer for?
