Questions for discussion and application:

- 1. What role does prayer play in spiritual warfare, as discussed earlier in Ephesians 6?
- 2. What does it mean to "pray in the Spirit at all times" (v. 18)?
- 3. The third point of the sermon was "We Pray Gospel Prayers." We are to pray for the work of furthering the gospel. Most prayers we hear in prayer meetings are focused on physical needs. How can you grow in praying gospel prayers?
- 4. Reflect on your current prayer practices. How can you incorporate more consistent and Spirit-led prayers into your daily routine?
- 5. Identify specific areas or people you feel called to pray for more fervently. Make a plan to incorporate these into your prayer time.
- 6. How do these verses challenge your current prayer life?
- 7. In what ways can you be more vigilant and persistent in your prayers?
- 8. When people ask you for prayer requests, think of how you can share gospel-centered requests. What is one gospel-centered request you can share right now?
