How to do this:

- a. Commit to maintaining a loving and merciful mindset toward the one who has offended you.
- b. Restore and begin to reconstruct relationship the moment the offender repents.
- c. Own your sins and shortcomings in the situation.
- d. Satisfy yourself with God's sovereign control of the situation.
- e. Stay focused on the forgiveness God continually demonstrates toward you.
