Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. As you read the Bible, what is one book of the Bible or passage that has been enriched for you in seeing where it fits in the greater biblical story?
- 2. In the message on Sunday, in thinking about how to use the Old Testament, we looked at Luke 24:25-27, 44-45; Romans 15:4; and 1 Corinthians 10:11. Share a way that one of the above passages has helped you as you read the Old Testament.
- 3. What happens when we detach the Old Testament from the gospel?
- 4. What is the point of the book of Judges (see Judges 17:6; 21:25. See also Judges 18:1; 19:1)?
- 5. What significant individual shows up in Ruth's last verse (Ruth 4:22)? Given that Ruth is in the time of the Judges (Ruth 1:1), how should we understand what God is doing in this small book?
- 6. Who is the Great King all Scripture points us to (see Heb 10:5-7)?
- 7. When we read the Scriptures, whether Old or New Testaments, it is the story of Jesus. How does this encourage you to read more of the Old Testament?
