Questions for Reflection and Application

1. How does Boaz's kindness to Ruth reflect the kindness and grace of Jesus Christ towards us?
2. In what ways can we see Boaz as a foreshadowing or type of Christ in this passage?
3. How does Ruth's position as a foreigner and a widow parallel our position before we come to Christ? How does Boaz's treatment of her mirror Christ's redemptive work?
4. How does Boaz's provision for Ruth foreshadow Christ's provision for His church?
5. In what specific ways can you be the hands and feet of Jesus in your community, as Boaz was to Ruth?
6. What are some ways you can ensure that your acts of kindness are rooted in the love of Christ and not merely in a sense of obligation?
7. Ask for prayer about one specific thing regarding how this text either challenges, comforts, or encourages you.
