2. Look at Matthew 5:23-24. How does Jesus connect reconciliation with God to reconciliation with others?

2. Reflect on the four directions of sin's fallout: upward, outward, inward, downward. Where have you experienced Christ's restoration in each of these areas?

3. Look at Matthew 22:37-39. How do the commands to love God and neighbor challenge the inward curvature caused by sin?

3. What is one practical step you can take this week to experience Christ's renewal in your relationships, self-perception, or interaction with creation?
